A Community Language Sharer is someone in the community who is able to and wants to share the language at community centers when Mvskoke Language Program staff can't, as our staff is limited. This new program allows us to support Speakers in the community who decide to share the language by paying them for their time.

If you are interested in sharing language at a community center and getting paid for your time, you need to talk with the community center you'd like to share language at. Decide with them what days of the week and times you will hold the classes and then call the Director at Mvskoke Language Program to see if a contract spot is available.

State Certification to Teach

If you are interested in teaching Mvskoke language at public schools, Mvskoke Language Program has a way to help you get certified through the state without needing a teaching degree or college degree. All you need is your Mvskoke knowledge.

We cannot find teaching locations for you, but if you know a school that is interested in hiring you and you would like to teach there, then we can help with the certification process. Then, when finished, you will use the Mvskoke I and II curriculum to teach in the classroom.

Once you have a school, call the Director at Mvskoke Language Program and you will be scheduled for a "Mvskoke Language Teaching Test". If you are a speaker, you will pass it easily. This test is only given because it is a requirement by Oklahoma State Department of Education.

We will then walk through with you on the other documents needed to turn in to the State to finish the process and let you know what steps you will have to do in the future to keep your certification.

- Find a school to teach at
- Call the Director at Mvskoke Language Program
- Schedule Language Test
- Work on other items with help from Mvskoke Language Program and submit
- Once everything is submitted, check in with the Director on what you will need to do in the future

In the meantime, the Mvskoke Language second-language staff are working hard to better develop their language abilities via practicing and testing immersion methods. Speaking with more and more people in the community help the second-language speakers get better and more comfortable--as well as meet more people.
